Tender Document (Terms and Conditions)

1. Sealed Tender should be deposited in sealed cover till 18th July 2017 on any working day between 10:00 to 5:00 pm or sent through speed post/ registered post to the office of Executive Director (CHEA) 06, Waldorf Compound, Mallital, Nainital.
2. Tender will be opened on 19th July 2017 at 11 a.m. in the office of Executive Director (CHEA) 06, Waldorf Compound, Mallital, Nainital.
3. The original copy of the tender documents, duly signed on each and every page by the tenderer should essentially be submitted with the tender.
4. On the top of the tender form, the tenderer should clearly state whether they are developers/ authorized suppliers.
5. In case the tender is submitted by an authorized distributor/ authorized product market suppliers, certificate from the developers should be submitted.
6. The tender should take care that the price of the equipments is quoted in such a way that no interpolation is possible. No blank should be left which would otherwise make the tender liable for rejection.
7. On award of the contract, installation of equipments shall be ensured :
 - a. **Item 01 Radiation Shield with mounting structure** needs to be installed at **Yuksam-Dzongri transect (Sikkim), and Daksum-Sinthan transect (Jammu & Kashmir).**
 - b. **Item 02 Item Temperature Logger** needs to be installed and demonstrated at **Yuksam-Dzongri transect (Sikkim), and Daksum-Sinthan transect (Jammu & Kashmir).**
 - c. **Item 03 Tipping Bucket Rainuage** with accessories needs to be installed and at **Yuksam-Dzongri transect (Sikkim) and Daksum-Sinthan transect (Jammu & Kashmir)** within the time frame indicated/ communicated to the party in tender form. This contractual delivery date/ period should be inclusive of all the lead-time. Training should be provided to person(s) deputed by the Department.
8. The tenderer should quote amount in figures as well in words. Alteration, if any should be attested by the tenderer. Each page of the tender should be duly signed by the tenderer himself, themselves by his/ their authorized agent on his / their behalf. In case the tender is signed by an agent, the authority letter in his favour must be enclosed with the tender.
9. Central Himalayan Environment Association (CHEA) Nainital reserves the right to cancel the purchase order in whole or any part of there and shall be entitled to revise the contract completely or in part by a written notice to the vendor, if.
 - a. The vendor fails to comply with the terms of the purchase order including technical features.
 - b. The vendor become bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
 - c. Receiver is appointed for any of the property owned by the vendor.
10. Unless otherwise specified in the order, the order price shall remain firm, will not be subjected to escalation of any description during the pending of the order.
11. The seller is liable to pay the taxes as per the prevalent rules.

12. The tender offer will be valid and binding on seller and purchase for a period of 03 month from the date of issue of tender notice.
13. A certificate of originality of the material and the equipments has to be submitted at the time of supply by the tender, whose tender is accepted purchase for; else the purchase order can be quashed.
14. Payment would be released after proper installation and demonstration of the equipments. However the conditions mentioned in the tender may be considered by the purchase committee regarding payment condition particularly for equipments to be imported. The delay in executing the purchase order shall mean and be limited to the following:
 - a. Any war/hostiles
 - b. Any riot or civil commotion
 - c. Any earthquake, flood, tempest, lightening or other natural, physical disasters.
 - d. Any Strike, or lockout (only those exceeding ten continuous days in duration) affecting the performance of the sellers obligations.
15. The seller shall intimate the ED, CHEA by the registered letter duly certified by local chamber of commerce or statutory authorities, the beginning and end of the above calls of delay within seven (7) days of occurrence and cessation of such force majeure, CHEA reserves the right to cancel the order.
16. For delay arising out of force majeure, the seller shall not claim extension in completion date for a period exceeding the period of delays attributable to cause of force majeure and neither the CHEA nor the seller be liable to pay extra, provided it is mutually established that the force majeure conditions did actually exist.
17. Registration certificates true attested copy by the gazette officer should also be enclosed.
18. Sales tax/ Income tax clearance certificate shall be submitted along with the tender document.
19. Terms and conditions shall also accompany the tender documents indicating the compliance of the party with the same.
20. Any attempt to use unfair means on the part of the tender to influence the decision will make this tender liable to rejection.
21. The tenders would be deemed to have understood and accepted all the terms and conditions. No enquires, verbal in writing, regarding acceptance or rejection of the tender shall be entertained.
22. The final order would be subjected to the technical features of the material and equipment and reliable after sale services and latest Government orders.
